The Lockport Township Board of Trustees met in the Central Square Board Room 318, 222 East Ninth Street, Lockport, Illinois on Monday October 3, 2016 at 7:16 PM with Supervisor Ron Alberico presided.

Present were Trustees John Batusich, Barb Boyce, Mike Lewandowski and Dean Morelli, Clerk Denise Mushro Rumchak, Highway Commissioner John Cielenski, Collector Lance McCalla, Attorney Gary Mueller, Deputy Clerk Jessica Strickland and Grant Spooner filming the meeting. Also present were Barb Delaney, Mava Zilka and Carl Bebrich. Absent was Debbi Mason. The meeting agenda was posted at the Lockport & Crest Hill Libraries, the Joliet Herald News, at the Central Square Building, the Lockport Township website (Clerk's section) and also on the Board Room door.

On a Motion of Boyce, seconded by Lewandowski to approve the minutes from the previous regular monthly meeting held on September 12, 2016.

Supervisor Alberico expressed it would be beneficial to Lockport Township residents to rent the two buses instead of the vans. Supervisor Alberico also suggested to use the current buses we have until the Pace buses become available. There was further discussion with the Board.

Clerk Rumchak expressed how the Lockport Township drivers made her feel proud. She witnessed one of the drivers helping a disable resident onto a bus and stated the drivers go unnoticed for their compassion and thoughtfulness.

Old Business- Supervisor Alberico mentioned the Shingle Shots Program will be held on Tuesday October 4, 2016 at the Walgreens in Crest Hill and Lockport. He also explained if there is enough monies left over in the budget, the Township will schedule one more event to accommodate the residents that could not take advantage of this wonderful program.

Supervisor Alberico announced the Senior Breakfast was today and it was a success. The Senior Breakfast will also be held on Tuesday and Wednesday of this week. Supervisor Alberico stated that residents can call to make their reservation for next year's breakfast in approximately three weeks.
