SENIOR FUND

The Lockport Township Board of Trustees met at the Lockport Township Government Building, Community Center, 1463 S. Farrell Road, Lockport, Illinois on Monday November 6, 2017 at 7:21 PM with Supervisor Ron Alberico presiding.

Present were Trustees Gregg Bickus, Barb Boyce, Barb Delaney and Dean Morelli, Assessor Debbi Mason, Clerk Denise Mushro Rumchak, Highway Commissioner John Cielenski, Attorney Gary Mueller and Deputy Clerk Jessica Strickland. Also present were- See attendance sheet. Absent was Collector Lance McCalla. The meeting agenda was posted at the Lockport & Crest Hill Libraries, Lockport Township Government Building, the Lockport Township website (Clerk's section), the calendar and also on the Community Center door.

On a Motion of Bickus, seconded by Boyce to approve the minutes from the previous regular monthly meeting held on October 2, 2017.

MOTION CARRIED

On a Motion of Boyce, seconded by Delaney to approve the total bills and payroll in the amount of \$31,185.17. Roll call vote resulted in Alberico Aye, Bickus Aye, Boyce Aye, Delaney Aye and Morelli Aye.

New Business- Supervisor Alberico reported he would like to put together a senior advisory board. He announced his interest of creating a board at the senior breakfast and received a lot of positive feedback from the residents. Trustee Delaney commented she would have no objection to creating a board as long as they are not compensated. Supervisor Alberico stated there would be no compensation. Trustee Morelli asked Supervisor Alberico if any residents have contacted him that are interested in being members of the board. Supervisor Alberico commented there are approximately 10 people who are interested, but he does want to speak to one individual first to see if she would like to take the lead on putting this board together.

On a Motion of Delaney, seconded by Boyce to approve the creation of a Senior Advisory Board. Roll call vote resulted in Alberico Aye, Bickus Aye, Boyce Aye, Delaney Aye and Morelli Aye.

Supervisor Alberico informed the Board that last year the Township agreed to provide the use of the Township buses for the CASA Christmas event. The CASA event will be held on December 2, 2017 and December 3, 2017. The buses would be used to get citizens back and forth from the designated buildings to the train stations. Trustee Bickus asked if the Township provides the drivers. Supervisor Alberico commented that the Township's donation to this program is the buses, drivers and gas.

On a Motion of Delaney, seconded by Boyce to approve the use of the Township buses for the CASA event in December 2017.

Trustee Delaney asked if the Lockport Township Transit System would consider extending their hours of operation to accommodate seniors that need a ride home after 3:00 PM. Supervisor Alberico explained that after 3:00 PM it is very difficult to route the buses to certain designations due to the ongoing issues with the 9<sup>th</sup> Street Bridge. There was additional discussion with the Board.

On a Motion of Boyce, seconded by Delaney to adjourn the meeting at 7:31 PM.
